The professorship will be the scientific head of the Methodology Lab at KIT's House of Competence (HoC).

We are seeking an internationally renowned expert in computational social science with research interests relevant to both the Institute of Technology Futures and the House of Competence. The successful candidate is expected to actively contribute to and shape the profiles of these two institutes.

In terms of teaching, the professorship will contribute 4-5 courses per semester to different, partly interdisciplinary programs (including, e.g., the B.A./M.A. program Science–Media–Communication, or HoC's scientific method curriculum). The professorship will also have an active role in (re)-designing our teaching programs.

Knowledge of the German language is not mandatory at the time of appointment. However, the successful candidate is expected to acquire proficiency in German within the first five years of her/his appointment.

KIT is pursuing a gender equality policy and encourages women to apply. Furthermore, in case of equal qualification preference is given to applicants with disabilities

The requirements for appointment correspond to § 47 of the Baden-Württembergisches Landeshochschulgesetz (LHG).
